

Important Announcement:
**China Sourcing Fair schedule changes in the event of
Black rainstorm / Typhoon signal no. 8 or higher**

Dear China Sourcing Fair attendees,

According to the Hong Kong Observatory forecast as of 21 October 2010, tropical cyclone Megi is edging closer to the South China coast, bringing strong winds and heavy rains to Hong Kong.

In the event that a black rainstorm signal or typhoon signal no. 8 (or higher) is hoisted during Fair dates, please refer to the following table regarding changes in the Fairs' opening hours:

Scenario	China Sourcing Fair schedule
Black rainstorm signal / Typhoon signal no. 8 (or higher) is hoisted before 10:00am	The China Sourcing Fairs will be closed.
Black rainstorm signal is lowered to Red signal / Typhoon signal no. 8 (or higher) is lowered to signal no. 3 (or lower) at or before 2:00pm	The China Sourcing Fairs will open two (2) hours after the announcement that the signal has been lowered.
Black rainstorm signal is lowered to Red signal/ Typhoon signal no. 8 (or higher) is lowered to signal no. 3 (or lower) after 2:00pm	The China Sourcing Fairs will remain closed for the rest of the day. The Fairs will open the following day, October 23, from 10:00am to 5:00pm. Registration counters open at 9:30am.

If a black rainstorm signal or typhoon signal no. 8 (or higher) is hoisted after the Fairs have opened (i.e. **after 10:00am**), the Fairs will be closed soon after the announcement. Please do not make your way to the venue anymore, and head back to your hotel instead. Visitors who are already at the venue will be asked to leave AsiaWorld-Expo immediately.
